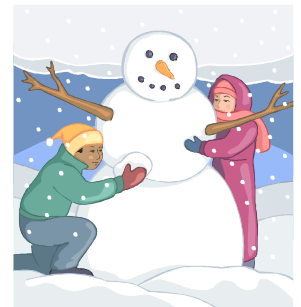
## Month in Review
