It will also provide Oakhill with documentation to hold charging your full deposit for the upcoming school year until an award is potentially made and accepted. All enrollments/re-enrollments are required to a \$500 non-refundable deposit per child until the final deposit amount is determined, at which point you will complete the process with final paperwork and the balance of your deposit payment due by March 1, 2023. A deposit is required to secure your aid amount and your student(s) space in a specific grade.
