



Financial Assistance Letter of Intent

Oakhill Day School understands the decision to send your child to a private independent institution can be a financial burden. We value your choice in making your child's education a priority and we are committed to assisting families with the cost of tuition.

The Financial Assistance Committee is responsible for determining all Financial Assistance awards and consists of a non-biased group of administrators and a non-parent board member. All information on the Financial Assistance application is kept confidential and is used solely for determining Financial Assistance.

This intent serves as a place holder for your child's space until a Financial Assistance award is determined. It will also provide Oakhill with documentation to hold charging your deposit for the upcoming school year.

This letter will reserve your child's space until the Financial Assistance award is determined (by February 15, 2021), at which point you will complete final paperwork and your deposit, due by March 1, 2021. The tuition deposit is required to secure your assistance amount and your student's space in a specific class.
