

Naming Opportunities South Campus

Common Space Areas

West Entry and Lobby \$100,000

Includes: Main entrance to Oakhill's South Campus, reception area, Nurse's Office, vestibule, bench(es), wall space with plaque, and outdoor signage to the South Campus.

Exterior Plaza FUNDED

Driveway Lane FUNDED

Restroom Facilities \$250,000

Upgraded restroom facilities will be on the first and second floor of the South Campus. Two additional restrooms will include one for students as needed in the Nurse's Office and one for staff.

A. First floor restrooms\$125,000

Includes: Four individual restrooms and three sinks for ladies. Four individual restrooms and three sinks for men.

B. Second floor restrooms\$100,000

Includes: Two individual restrooms and two sinks for ladies. Three individual restrooms and three sinks for men.

C. Two individual restrooms\$25,000

Includes: Two private restrooms with sinks, one per floor, will be available for student and staff use as needed.

Commons/Multipurpose Area \$165,000

The Commons/Multipurpose Area is the largest feature on the first floor and will be utilized similarly to the North Campus Commons for lunchtime, meetings, assemblies, presentations, lighting features, upgraded ceiling, and more.

The individual features within the Commons/Multipurpose Area include:

A. Lunch Space\$55,000

Includes: Tables/seating for daily lunches, recycling center for all day use, condiment station for lunch, and signage.

B. Technology\$55,000

Includes: Two motorized projectors and Wi-Fi with sound system in built-in cabinet, lighting features, and upgraded ceiling for collaboration and class use in the Commons space and signage.

C. Assemblies/Collaboration\$55,000

Includes: Space for South Campus assemblies, student collaboration, and classroom use as needed and signage.

Media Center.....

The Media Center will have features of our North Campus Library, but benefitting for Middle School students with the latest technological advancements. This area will be the hub of the South Campus, becoming the heart of the space.

The individual features within the Media Center include:

A. Research\$50,000

Includes: eBooks, educational resources, tables, technology, and docking stations for student laptops, and signage.

B. Project Space\$50,000

Includes: Furnishings for teacher/student group work, team space to work together on classroom ideas, and signage.

C. Learning/Class Use\$50,000

Includes: Ability to use and meet collectively as a class or small group with tables/chairs, docking stations, and signage.

D. Traditional Library FUNDED

Open Collaborative Project Area (3 total included)..... \$10,000

Two spaces will be utilized on the second floor and one on the first floor that allow for students and teachers to move outside the typical classroom for learning and group projects. Areas will include open shelving, wall covering and marker boards with easy-to-move seating, and features signage.

Hive Student Storage \$20,000

Students will have their own space to store backpacks, extra supplies and extra-curricular gear for the given school year. Storage will be an open, beehive design. Student storage will be located on either the first or second floor, depending on grade and will feature signage in four locations (2 per floor).

South Campus Kitchen \$250,000

The South Campus kitchen will feed fourth through eighth grade daily with a wide variety of healthy, nutritious foods matching the Oakhill wellness program via a variety of serving options while meeting the desires of the students.

A. Cooking Area\$100,000

Includes: Cooking area for daily food preparation, student cooking class demonstration/participation, demo kitchen station with movable cart station and permanent sinks in the Commons for student cooking classes, and signage. B.

Serving Area\$100,000

Includes: Multiple serving options for students featuring a scramble bar, grab-n-go bar, salad and soup bar, entrée and sides bar, ice cream machine, as well as additional trays and plates for serving various lunch options, and signage.

C. Cleaning Area\$50,000

Includes: Kitchen cooking area components with dishwashing stations, food and supply storage, and signage.

Science Wing \$240,000

The Science Wing of the South Campus will be home to science education with state of the art features for fourth through eighth grade classes and features signage.

A. Science Demo Class\$75,000

Includes: Student space for science classroom instruction, student seating, movable furniture/storage, and signage.

B. Science Lab Class\$115,000

Includes: Gas hood, four sinks with gas hookups, eye wash station, demonstration area, student work stations, supplies/materials, sheet vinyl flooring for easy cleanup and safety, flexibility in space for all sciences, and signage.

C. Science Technology\$50,000

Includes: Technology components needed for all science class demonstration and lab, and will feature signage.

Learning Stairs FUNDED

The Learning Stairs are the connection center for the first and second floors and can also be used as a collaborative learning and classroom space. These are not only a visual feature for the South Campus, but are a practical inclusion and provides an opportunity for students to learn in a unique location. Will feature signage.

South Campus Security \$50,000

Security for our students is one of our top priorities and the South Campus will be completely secured separate from the remainder of the second and third floors with no access from the east side of the building without keycard. Features will also include panic doors from the west side, security cameras, key card access and firewalls and will feature signage.

Middle School Division Head Office \$25,000

This office space will house the Middle School Division Head and will act additionally as a space for individual student/teacher meetings, small staff meetings, parent/teacher meetings, and tutoring as needed and will feature signage.

South Campus Tech Hub \$25,000

Information Technology is very important to the daily activities at Oakhill and the heart of that technology is housed in this server room. IT staff will also reside in this space to take care of the technological needs of those in the building and space will feature signage.

Conference Room \$20,000

This multipurpose space will be used for both internal/external meetings, parent/teacher meetings, small student presentational space, STUCO meetings, and can also be used for project/collaborative programs. Room will feature a flat screen and additional technology and will feature signage.

Project Collaboration Room..... FUNDED

Teacher Resource/Work Room FUNDED

Print Stations\$10,000

Students and teachers will have access to five print stations located throughout the South Campus for all printing needs. Stations will include a counter, docking station for technology and will feature signage.

Classrooms

Classrooms (9 available) \$15,000/each \$135,000

Nine specific classroom spaces to serve grades and subjects for fourth through eighth grade. All classroom furnishings will be movable within each space and will feature student seating. One wall will be a white wall for teacher/student use. Each room will have natural lighting and be a flexible, sustainable space different from a traditional classroom with signage. Classroom breakout includes:

Specials (Music, Art and Spanish)

Music Classroom FUNDED

Classroom will house music classes for fourth through eighth grade and individual student music lessons after school. The room will feature risers, acoustic tiles, piano, movable furniture, and will feature signage.

Music Storage Room \$10,000

Music Practice Room \$10,000

Art Classroom \$25,000

Classroom will house all art classes for fourth and eighth grade. The room will feature creation space for all forms of art, including mixed media, painting, photography, ceramics, and more. Room will have moveable furniture and house painting easels, pottery wheels, supplies, sheet vinyl flooring for easy cleanup and safety, and will feature signage.

Kiln Studio \$10,000

The Kiln Studio will feature the kiln to fire all South Campus ceramics and will be ventilated and serve as dedicated space for pottery projects and finishing, and will feature signage.

Spanish Classroom \$25,000

Classroom will house Spanish classes for fourth through eighth grade and will utilize movable furniture/storage and will feature signage.

Specials Technology (3 available) \$10,000/each \$30,000

Three South Campaign Specials (Music, Art and Spanish) specific classroom technology features to serve grades and subjects for the South Campus including interactive marker boards in each room with touch pen technology and offers signage. Breakout includes:

Music Classroom Technology	\$10,000
Art Classroom Technology	\$10,000
Spanish Classroom Math Technology	\$10,000
